SPARSH Hospital for Advanced Surgeries, a new unit of SPARSH Hospital is a dedicated centre for Joint Replacement Surgery. With an increase in our aging population, the incidence of degenerative Arthritis has assumed endemic proportions leading to suffering and reduced quality of life. Joint Replacement Surgery has the ability to relive pain and improve quality of life in patients suffering with Arthritis. However, the surgery is exacting and requires great precision to achieve the desired clinical outcomes and longevity of the prosthesis.

We propose to conduct the Sparsh Arthroplasty Course - Basic in the second weekend of March and the Sparsh Arthroplasty Course - Advanced in the second weekend of September every year. These courses will be conducted by the Institute of Joint Replacement at Sparsh Hospital for Advanced Surgeries in collaboration with the world leaders in the field, namely, Endo-Klinik in Hamburg, Germany and Wrightington Hospital in U.K.

The highlights of basic course will be (with a limited number of delegates):

- Live surgery: Primary Hip and Knee Arthroplasty
- Saw-bone workshop
- Cementing technique workshop (based on Wrightington Course)

The advanced course will involve:

- Live surgery: Difficult primary Hip and Knee Arthroplasty
- Live surgery: Revision Joint Arthroplasty
- Workshop on removal of cemented and un-cemented prosthesis (based on Endo-Klinik Course)
- Impaction bone grafting technique workshop (based on Endo-Klinik Course)

Four delegates each from the basic and advanced courses will be selected for a six month Arthroplasty Fellowship which includes four months in India and two months in Europe.
